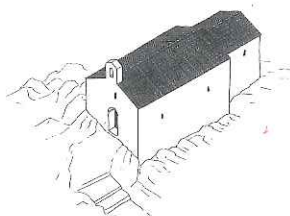

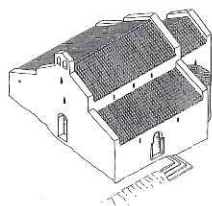

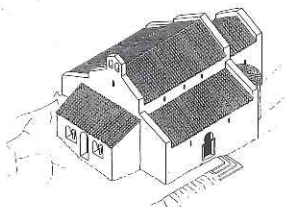
History building development of the church of Sant Quirze de Pedret



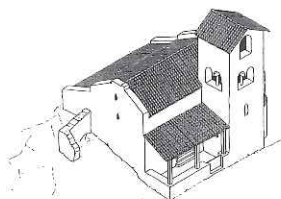
Last third of the 9th century



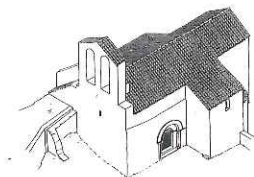
Mid 10th century



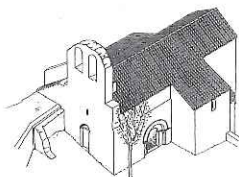
First quarter of the 11th century



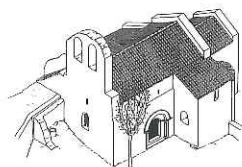

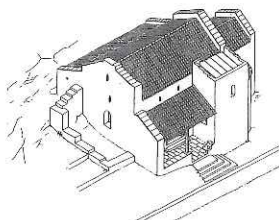

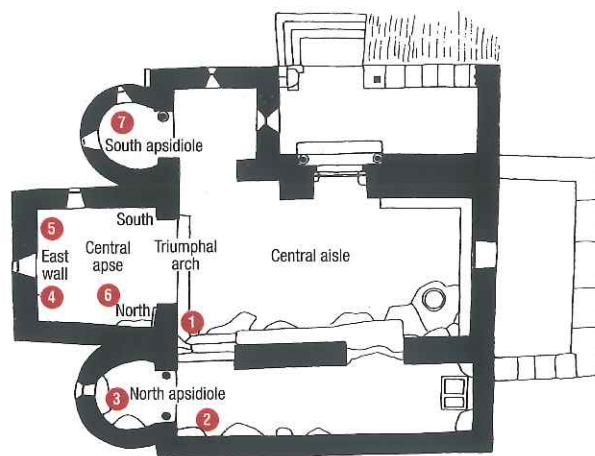

Central aisle and triumphal arch

Romanesque paintings (possibly from the end of the 11th century) found *in situ* and restored in 1995.

1. Remains of what must have been the cycle of the martyrdom of the saints after whom the church is named, Sant Quirze and Santa Julita, and a fragment that shows the sacrifice of Isaac.

The upper part is delimited by a grecque which alternates with the representation of the busts of saints.

Restorers: M. Teresa Novell, Rosa Laura Janó, Xavier Rossell.

From 1940, the Diocesan and District Museum of Solsona keeps other remains of this fragment, removed in 1937.
